In the notification of Government of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (Department of Health) No. G.S.R. 356(E), dated the 7th June, 2005, [Prevention of Food Adulteration (Fourth Amendment) Rules, 2005] published in Part II, Section 3, Sub-section (i) at pages 1-77 of the Gazette of India, Extraordinary and read with Corrigendum G.S.R. 706(E), dated 6th December, 2005, G.S.R. 131(E), dated 3th March, 2006, G.S.R. 532(E), dated 5th September, 2006 and G.S.R. 575(E), dated 5th September, 2007 published in Part II, Section 3, Sub-section (i) of the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, at page 44, sub-rule (2) of rule 1, shall read as follow,-

"(2) They shall come into force after nine months except clause (a), items No. A.11.02.06, A. 11.02.06.01, A.11.02.06.02 of clause (f), items No. A.11.02.07, A.11.02.07.01, 11.02.07.02, A.11.02.08 of clause (g) and clause (m) of sub-rule (ii) of rule 2 and entries relating thereto in Table 14 of Appendix-C and Table 3 of Appendix-D, which shall come into force after three years and six months from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette."
