## **NOTIFICATION**

New Delhi, the 25th July, 2005

- \*S.O. 1068(E) -- In pursuance of Sub-section (6) of Section 3 of the Prevention of Food Adulteration Act, 1954 (37 of 1954), and after previous approval of Central Government, the Central Committee for Food Standards hereby makes the following amendment in the Central Committee for Food Standards (Procedure and Transaction of Business) Bye-Laws, 1986, namely:-
- 1. (1) These Bye-Laws may be called the **Central Committee for Food Standards** (Procedure and Transaction of Business) Amendment Bye-Laws, 2005.
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of the notification in the Official Gazette.
- 2. In the Central Committee for Food Standards (Procedure and Transaction of Business) Bye-Laws, 1986, in Bye-Law 9, for clause (2), the following shall be substituted, namely:-
  - "(2) When any papers mentioned in clause (1) are sent to the members by circulation, a period of not less than 21 clear days shall be allowed for the receipt of replies from the members and such period shall be counted from the date on which the said papers are so sent. The letter shall be sent by the fastest mode of postage."
