## **ORDER**

## New Delhi, the 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2005

\*S.O. 957(E).— Whereas, the Central Government, after considering the recommendations made to it by the Standing Advisory Committee, had directed by Order S.O. 1057(E) dated 28<sup>th</sup> September, 2004, regarding commodities specified in Column 2 of the Schedule of that order, shall be packed in jute packaging material, for supply or distribution, in such minimum such percentage, as specified in the corresponding entries in Column (3) of the said Schedule;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-section (1) of Section 3 of the Jute Packaging Materials (Compulsory Use in Packing Commodities) Act, 1987 (10 of 1987), the Central Government hereby directs that the validity of aforesaid order expiring on 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2005 shall be extended until 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2005 or until further orders, whichever is earlier.
